From the Circles - Dark Blue (H), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 411 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Leaves - Light Blue (I), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Stars - Dark Blue (J), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Berries - Light Blue (K), cut:

- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Novelty Toss - Dark Blue (L), cut:

- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Novelty Toss - Light Blue (M), cut:

- (1) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Stars - Light Blue (N), cut:

- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Stripe - Brown (O), cut:
-(5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Novelty Toss - Taupe (Backing), cut:

- (2) 49 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 49 " x $63 "$ back.


## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 28 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the 14 " $\times 28^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 17" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 16" x 30".

From the Leaves - Cream (G), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $21 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 35^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 23^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 471 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $11 / 2 " \times 351 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
From the Panel - Cream (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 14 " $\times 28$ " rectangle, centered on the tree.
- (20) $3^{1 / 2 "}$ " squares, each centered on a small square.

From the Stripe - Light Blue (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " x 28 " WOF strips.
- (1) $2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 " \times 17 "$ strips.

From the Berries - Pink (C), cut:

- (2) $11 / 4 " \times 30$ " WOF strips.
- (1) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $11 / 4 " \times 171 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Berries - Sage (D), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Circles - Butternut (E), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Stars - Sage (F), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

Follow Figure 2 and sew together (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip and (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Inner Left Side Border.
3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip and (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Inner Right Side Border.

4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together end to end (1) $21 / 2$ " Fabric D square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip and (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, in that order from left to right, to make the Inner Top Border.

5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together end to end (1) $21 / 2$ "

Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square and (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make the Inner Bottom Border.

6. Place (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric I square on the left side of (1) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 7).

7. Place another $11 / 2 "$ Fabric I square on the right side of the $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 9).
8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (16) Unit 1 strips total.

12. Sew together (6) $21 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric G strips and (5) assorted Blocks, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Outer Left Side Border (Fig. 21).
13. Repeat Step 12 and refer to Figures 22-24 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Outer Right Side Border, Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 14. (1) $11 / 4 " \times 30 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 171 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew the Inner Left Side Border and Inner Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
16. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 35 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 231 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
18. Sew the Outer Left Side Border and Outer Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
19. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
20. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 471 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 351 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
21. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 41 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
22. Layer and quilt as desired.
23. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric O strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
24. Bind as desired.
