#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Panel - Cream (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 14" x 28" rectangle, centered on the tree.
- (20) 3 ½" squares, each centered on a small square.

#### From the Stripe - Light Blue (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 28" WOF strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 17" strips.

#### From the Berries - Pink (C), cut:

- (2) 1 1/4" x 30" WOF strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/4" x 17 1/2" strips.

#### From the Berries - Sage (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Circles - Butternut (E), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 2 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Stars - Sage (F), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 2 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Leaves - Cream (G), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" x 5 ½" strips.
- (7) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 1 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 1 ½" squares.
- (2) 1 ½" x 35 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 23 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 47 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 35 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Circles - Dark Blue (H), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 49 ½" strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x 41 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Leaves - Light Blue (I), cut:

• (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 ½" squares.

#### From the Stars - Dark Blue (J), cut:

• (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 ½" squares.

#### From the Berries - Light Blue (K), cut:

• (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" squares.

#### From the Novelty Toss - Dark Blue (L), cut:

• (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" squares.

#### From the Novelty Toss - Light Blue (M), cut:

• (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" squares.

#### From the Stars - Light Blue (N), cut:

• (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" squares.

#### From the Stripe - Brown (O), cut:

• (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Novelty Toss - Taupe (Backing), cut:

• (2) 49" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 49" x 63" back.

#### **Block Assembly**

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 28" Fabric B strip to each side of the 14" x 28" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 17" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 16" x 30".







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
- 2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric F strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric D strip and (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Inner Left Side Border.
- 3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric F strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric F strip, (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric D strip and (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Inner Right Side Border.




4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together end to end (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric F strip, (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric F strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E square, in that order from left to right, to make the Inner Top Border.




5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together end to end (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square and (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make the Inner Bottom Border.




6. Place (1) 1 ½" Fabric I square on the left side of (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 7).




- 7. Place another 1 ½" Fabric I square on the right side of the 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 9).
- 8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (16) Unit 1 strips total.







9. Repeat Steps 6-7 and refer to Figures 10-14 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make the indicated number of unit strips for Unit 2 through Unit 6.






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






10. Sew (1) 1 1/2" Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 5 ½" Block One square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.





11. Repeat Step 10 and refer to Figures 16-20 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of block squares for Block Two through Block Six.














- 12. Sew together (6) 2 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric G strips and (5) assorted Blocks, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Outer Left Side Border (Fig. 21).
- 13. Repeat Step 12 and refer to Figures 22-24 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Outer Right Side Border, Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border.









#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
14. (1) 1 1/4" x 30" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 17 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 15. Sew the Inner Left Side Border and Inner Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 17. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 35 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 23 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 18. Sew the Outer Left Side Border and Outer Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

- 19. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 20. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 47 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 35 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 21. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 49 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 41 ½" Fabric Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 22. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 23. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric O strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 24. Bind as desired.
