Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Berries - Pink (A), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 4 ½" triangles.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Stripe - Light Blue (B), cut:

- (1) 4 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 4 ¹/₄" triangles.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2" squares.

From the Stars - Dark Blue C), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.

From the Novelty Toss - Dark Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.

From the Circles - Dark Blue (E), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" squares.

From the Circles - Light Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" squares.

From the Novelty Toss - Light Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" squares.

From the Stars - Light Blue (H), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.

From the Berries - Light Blue (I), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2" squares.

From the Leaves - Light Blue (J), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2" squares.

From the Stars - Sage (K), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 15 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 17 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 23 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 25 ½" WOF strips.

From the Panel - Cream (L):

• Fussy cut (20) 3 ½" squares, each centered on a square.

From the Leaves - Cream (M), cut:

- (9) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (188) 2" squares.
- (10) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (112) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Stripe - Brown (N), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 27 ½" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Berries - Sage (O), cut:

• (3) 2" x WOF strips.

From the Circles - Butternut (P), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (22) 3 ½" squares.
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 54 ½" strips.

From the Leaves - Seal Brown (Backing), cut:

• (2) 62" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 62" back.

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
Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" Fabric H square to the left side of (1) 2" Fabric I square to make the top row. Sew (1) 2" Fabric I square to the left side of (1) 2" Fabric H square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 3 ½" Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 square.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 5.




- 3. Follow Figure 6 and sew together (2) 4 1/4" Fabric A triangles and (2) 4 1/4" Fabric B triangles to make (1) 3 1/2" Unit 6 square. Repeat to make a second Unit 6 square.
- 4. Follow Figure 7 and sew together (2) 4 1/4" Fabric B triangles and (2) 4 1/4" Fabric A triangles to make (1) 3 ½" Unit 7 square. Repeat to make a second Unit 7 square.






- 5. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 3 ½" Fabric D square, (1) Unit 2 square and (1) 3 ½" Fabric E square together in that order from left to right to make Row One (Fig. 8).
- 6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figure 8 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Five.
- 7. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 4-5, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make 15 ½" x 15 ½" Unit 8 square (Fig. 8).



8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 15 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Unit 8 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 17 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 8 square to make the Unit 9 square (Fig. 9).



- 9. Sew together (5) 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric K strips and (4) 3 ½" Fabric L squares, alternating them from top to bottom. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of the Unit 9 square (Fig. 10).
- 10. Sew together (6) 3 ½" Fabric L squares and (5) 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric K strips, alternating them from left to right. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 9 square to make the 23 ½" x 23 ½" Center Block (Fig. 10).



11. Place (1) 2" Fabric M square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 12).

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- 12. Place another 2" Fabric M square on the right side of the 2" x 3 ½" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 13). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 13). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 14).
- 13. Repeat Steps 11-12 to make (36) Unit 10 strips total.





- 14. Sew together (9) Unit 10 strips, end to end, to make (1) Inner Side Border (Fig. 15). Inner Side Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border.
- 15. Sew together (9) Unit 10 strip, end to end. Sew (1) 2" Fabric M square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Inner Top Border (Fig. 16). Repeat to make the Inner Bottom Border.







16. Sew (1) 2" x WOF Fabric O strip to the left side of (2) 2" x WOF Fabric K strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (3) Strip Set 1's total.

17. Cut the (3) Strip Set 1's into (44) 2" x 3 ½" Unit 11 strips (Fig. 18).




18. Sew together (2) Unit 11 strips lengthwise to make (1) 3 ½" Unit 12 square (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (22) Unit 12 squares total.



- 19. Sew together (5) Unit 12 squares and (5) 3 ½" Fabric P squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Middle Left Side Border (Fig. 20).
- 20. Repeat Step 19 and refer to Figures 21-23 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Middle Right Side Border, the Middle Top Border and the Middle Bottom Border.




21. Repeat Steps 11-12 and refer to Figure 24 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction while using (16) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric M strips and (32) 2" Fabric J squares to make (16) Unit 13 strips.



22. Repeat Steps 11-12 and refer to Figures 25-31 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make the indicated number of unit strips for Unit 14 through Unit 20.




















23. Sew (1) 2" Fabric M square to each end of (1) Unit 13 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 13 strip to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make Block One (1) 6 ½" Block One square (Fig. 32). make 4 Repeat to make (4) Block One squares





24. Repeat Step 23 and refer to Figures 33-39 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of block squares for Block Two through Block Eight.















25. Follow Figure 40 and sew together (6) assorted Blocks to make the Outer Left Side Border. Repeat to make the Outer Right Side Border (Fig. 41).



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26. Follow Figure 42 and sew (8) assorted Blocks together to make the Outer Top Border. Repeat to make the Outer Bottom Border (Fig. 43).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 27. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 23 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 25 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

28. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 25 ½" Fabric N strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 27 ½" Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 29. Sew the Inner Left Side Border and Inner Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 30. Sew the Middle Left Side Border and Middle Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Middle Top Border and Middle Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 31. Sew the Outer Left Side Border and Outer Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 32. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric P strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric P strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 33. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 34. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric N strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 35. Bind as desired.
