From the Stars - Light Blue (H), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.

From the Berries - Light Blue (I), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 " squares.

From the Leaves - Light Blue (J), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 " squares.

From the Stars - Sage (K), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1 / 2 " x}{} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 15 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 17 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 231 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{11 / 2 "}{} \times 25^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
From the Panel - Cream (L):
- Fussy cut (20) $31 / 2$ " squares, each centered on a square.

From the Leaves - Cream (M), cut:

- (9) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (188) 2" squares.
- (10) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (112) 2" x $31 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Stripe - Brown (N), cut:

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 25^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 27^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Berries - Sage (O), cut:
-(3) 2" x WOF strips.
From the Circles - Butternut (P), cut:
- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (22) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
-(3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Leaves - Seal Brown (Backing), cut:

- (2) 62 " $x$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62 " $\times 62$ " back.


## O CHRISTMAS TREE <br> Quilt 2

Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" Fabric H square to the left side of (1) 2 " Fabric I square to make the top row. Sew (1) $2 "$ Fabric I square to the left side of
 (1) $2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) $31 / 2 "$ Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 square.
2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 5.

3. Follow Figure 6 and sew together (2) $41 / 4$ " Fabric A triangles and (2) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric B triangles to make (1) $31 / 2 "$ Unit 6 square. Repeat to make a second Unit 6 square.
4. Follow Figure 7 and sew together (2) $41 / 4$ " Fabric B triangles and (2) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric A triangles to make (1) $31 / 2$ " Unit 7 square. Repeat to make a second Unit 7 square.
5. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) Unit 2 square and (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E square together in that order from left to right to make Row One (Fig. 8).
6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figure 8 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Five.
7. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 4-5, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make $151 / 2 " \times 15 \frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 8 square (Fig. 8).

8. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 15 \frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric K strip to each side of the Unit 8 square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 171 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 8 square to make the Unit 9 square (Fig. 9).

Fabric L squares, alternating them from top to bottom. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of the Unit 9 square (Fig. 10).
10. Sew together (6) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric $L$ squares and (5) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric K strips, alternating them from left to right. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 9 square to make the $231 / 2 " \times 231 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Center Block (Fig. 10).

11. Place (1) $2 "$ Fabric M square on the left side of (1) $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 12).

Quilt 2
12. Place another 2" Fabric M square on the right side of the 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 13). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 13). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 14).
13. Repeat Steps 11-12 to make (36) Unit 10 strips total.

14. Sew together (9) Unit 10 strips, end to end, to make (1) Inner Side Border (Fig. 15). Inner Side Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border.
15. Sew together (9) Unit 10 strip, end to end. Sew (1) 2" Fabric M square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Inner Top Border (Fig. 16). Repeat to make the Inner Bottom Border.

16. Sew (1) $2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF Fabric O strip to the left side of (2) 2 " x WOF Fabric K strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (3) Strip Set 1's total.
17. Cut the (3) Strip Set 1's into (44) 2" x 3 ½" Unit 11 strips (Fig. 18).
20. Repeat Step 19 and refer to Figures 21-23 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Middle Right Side Border, the Middle Top Border and the Middle Bottom Border.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 27. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 23^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric $K$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
28. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric N strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 271 / 2 "$ Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
29. Sew the Inner Left Side Border and Inner Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
30. Sew the Middle Left Side Border and Middle Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Middle Top Border and Middle Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
31. Sew the Outer Left Side Border and Outer Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
32. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric P strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric P strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
33. Layer and quilt as desired.
34. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric N strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
35. Bind as desired.
