

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE PARISH COUNCIL OF BARMSTON &
FRAISTHORPE held in THE VILLAGE HALL, BARMSTON
on Wednesday 17th October 2018 at 3.00pm**

104. Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf of Councillor I Lawson

105. Declaration of Pecuniary and Non-Pecuniary Interests in relation to this Agenda in accordance with the Localism Act 2011 There were none.

106. Planning Applications

106.1 Single storey rear extension to The Rectory, 20 Sands Lane, Barmston. After discussion, Councillor Austerfield proposed and Councillor Riby seconded the proposal to recommend that this application be granted. The motion was carried 4 to 1. Councillor Wiles objected on the grounds that no site visit had taken place.

106.2 Conversion of redundant agricultural building to a dwelling for farm occupancy at Manor Farm, Main Street, Fraisthorpe . After discussion, Councillor Riby proposed and Councillor Austerfield seconded the proposal to recommend that this application be granted. The motion was carried unanimously.

107. Festive Lighting

The clerk reported that Helen Carter is not able to switch on the lights. The Chairman proposed and Councillor Austerfield seconded the proposal to ask Councillor Swift to switch them on. The motion was passed unanimously. Councillor Swift expressed his thanks for being asked and accepted the invitation. Councillor Swift will speak to a resident to arrange Father Christmas' visit to the event. Councillor Swift also reported that Sandhill are having to buy in the Christmas Trees this year and he is waiting for them to let us have a quotation for the cost. It was agreed that if the price is up to a maximum of £120, it should be ordered from Sandhills. If the cost is over this, then Councillor Wiles will speak with Lowthorpe Estate to see if they can supply one.

108. Parish Council Representative on Trustees of the Village Hall

At the meeting of the parish council on the 10th October, Councillor Marshall expressed her willingness to continue to represent the parish council on the Trustees of the Barmston & Fraisthorpe Village Hall. Councillor Swift proposed and Councillor Swift seconded the proposal to appoint Councillor Marshall and the motion was carried unanimously
