A message from Rev'd Richard Hare – Vicar of All Saints

I've got a lot to be thankful for. I had a wonderful sabbatical, with plenty of time to recharge my batteries. It included two long cycle adventures on my e-bike, first coast-to-coast from Morecambe Bay to Bridlington, and then from Carlisle to Inverness via the south and west coasts of Scotland, taking in the Isle of Arran on the way. I had a week's retreat at Scargill House, in the Yorkshire Dales. I had plenty of time with family, in Durham, Leamington and Luton, and a holiday in Keswick. I helped out at a summer camp with teenagers (including driving a scarily large minibus). I attended the Green Pastures conference, which is the national homelessness charity that partners with our own Hope Housing Bridlington. And in between all of these things I spent many days cycling to Barmston Church and back to write a book! It was all such fun.

Out on the bike in the sunshine it's easy to thank God for the beauty all around and the sheer fun of riding through the countryside. For you it might be walking the dog rather than pedalling – whatever it is, I think we all need regularly to appreciate and be thankful for the good things we enjoy. That includes the seaside, of course, but also our family and friends, our health (if we have it), holidays and other things we've enjoyed in the past, to name just a few.

Harvest is a time of celebration and thanksgiving for our food, the world around us, and everything we've been given. Our Harvest Festival will be on Sun 9th October at 4.00 pm, and we invite you to come and thank God together then. Church will be open the day before if you'd like to bring gifts of produce to decorate the church.
