## Minutes of the previous Council meeting and the Annual Parish Council Meeting (AGM) 10<sup>th</sup> May 2023

#### The Village Hall

The Village Hall was discussed at length.

Cllr Bedwell explained in detail the Insurance cover for the Village Hall explaining that is was a very in depth cover.

Various ideas were put forward and discussed on ways to move forward, but the main issue is still the lack of volunteers and helpers.

Many Village Halls are having the same problems as Barmston are having.

#### Upkeep of the Village Pond

It was suggested to see about employing a gardener to clear and maintain this area on a regular basis. Cllr Riby to investigate options.
