Altitudes indicated thus (s.m.s.) refer to bench marks on buildings, walls, &c. those marked thus (s) preceded or followed by the height, to surface levels.  
Ordnance Survey Datum, i.e. assumed mean sea level at Liverpool, and are not based on the revised primary levelling of 1922-21. There may thus be discrepancies of some inches between the contours and the bench marks and spot levels.  
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N.B. - The representation on this map of a Road, Track or Footpath is no evidence of the existence of a right of way.
