PRECEPT

The estimate of expenses for the ensuing year were discussed and it was RESOLVED to sign a precept of £20 (Twenty Pounds) for the General and £65 (Sixty Five Pounds) for the Lighting and Watching account, as approved by the Annual Parish Meeting.

ADVERTISEMENTS

The Chairman reported that permission has been given to Messrs Mills & Rockley to erect hoardings on the Rose & Brown Wall at on the Old Fire Station.

PLANS OF NEW HOUSING SITE

The plans of the new housing site were submitted to the Council by Mr J. A. Seale, who suggested that the footpath round the green be widened to take tradesmen's vans and that 4 bungalows be erected on the left and 2 on the right at the entrance from Colne Rd.

Mr Seale agreed to put these suggestions to the next meeting of the St Ives Rural District Housing Committee, and it was RESOLVED that a letter of support be written to the Rural District Council.

NAMING OF STREETS.

In reply to a letter from the St Ives Rural District Council, the following street names were agreed upon: Needingworth Rd, Station Rd, Rectory Rd, Earith Rd, Holliday's Rd, East Street, High Street, Wood End, The Heath, The Lane, and Colne Rd.

It was suggested that the new housing site be named "Presses Close".
