Certified biocyclic vegan farms use the **Biocyclic** Vegan Quality Seal to label their products as "vegan from the field", which is currently a unique selling point in the growing market for plant-based foods. For this, in addition to the EU (or other national) organic inspection, an inspection is carried out by an independent control body under the Biocyclic Vegan Standard.



With the Biocyclic Vegan Quality Seal, products can be recognised as vegan from the field.

Biocyclic vegan agriculture

Biocyclic vegan means growing organically with plant-based fertilisers. This includes compost, Biocyclic Humus Soil, transfer mulch or field bean meal, green manure, and a high percentage of legumes in the crop rotation.

According to the Biocyclic Vegan Standard. animal husbandry and the use of animal fertilisers or other inputs of animal origin are not allowed.

Biocyclic yegan agriculture attaches great importance to increasing soil fertility through a systematic humus build-up. The cultivation is regenerative, with crop rotations that are as wide as possible, abundant ground cover, intercropping and a large variety of cultures. Additionally, biodiversity is explicitly promoted as an essential part of preventive plant protection
