



Bluntisham Cricket Club – Covid update 14.7.20

At last we have some ECB guidance on progressing from stage 3 to stage 4 on the roadmap for allowing recreational cricket to return.

There are extensive guidelines here and do's and don'ts. BCC committee have been meeting regularly and we are committed to complying with all guidance both from the ECB and the Parish Council.

In line with the measures below BCC will ensure the following;

- All players & officials' temperatures will be taken prior to any game starting. If anyone displays a temperature they will be asked to go home immediately. The temperature checks will be carried out using a handheld non-contact forehead thermometer.
- All payments are made using a SUM Up card payment machine so no cash on match days.
- A register of all players, officials and spectators will be taken to ensure track and trace can be invoked if required.
- BCC will ensure sufficient hand sanitiser is available in line with the ECB requirements.
- BCC will mark out social distancing areas to ensure ECB requirements are met.
- No teas will be taken, if players wish, they will bring their own refreshment. The kitchen area will not be open for anyone. BCC will supply bottled water for players and officials.
- Players will arrive changed and BCC will not be using any changing room facilities.
- The old village hall toilets will be unlocked on match days and will have a one in one out system when needed and locked when not in use. BCC will clean and sanitise the toilets before and after matches and will provide adequate hand washing facilities.

Bluntisham Parish Council are pleased to welcome Bluntisham Cricket Club back and wish them a successful albeit short season of cricket.
