

COVID-19 Risk Assessment for re-opening Bluntisham Play park and outdoor gym – July 2020

Area or People at Risk	Risk identified	Actions to take to mitigate risk	Notes
All users	Cleaning surfaces infected by people carrying the virus. Disposing of rubbish containing tissues and cleaning cloths. Deep cleaning premises if someone falls ill with CV-19 on the premises.	Stay at home guidance if unwell at entrance to play park and outdoor gym. Play park, outdoor gym, fencing and gates to be sprayed with disinfectant on a weekly basis. Staff advised to wash outer clothes after cleaning duties. Staff given PHE guidance and PPE for use in the event deep cleaning is required. Users advised not to congregate and allow more than one household to use any piece of equipment at any one time. Reminders around personal hygiene to be provided in and around equipment. If anyone falls ill the playpark will be closed for 72 hours and deep cleaned before re-opening.	Staff will need to be warned immediately if someone is tested positive for COVID-19 who has been on the premises.
Car Park/paths/ patio/exterior areas	Social distancing is not observed as people congregate before entering premises. Parking area is too congested to allow social distancing. People drop tissues.	Mark out 2 metre waiting area outside all potential entrances with spray paint to encourage care when queueing to enter. Internal and external bins emptied weekly and disposed of by HDC.	Transitory lapses in social distancing in outside areas are less risky, the main risk is likely to be where people congregate or for vulnerable people. Ordinary litter collection arrangements can remain in place. Provide plastic gloves.
Entrance and exits	Possible “pinch points” and busy areas where risk is social distancing is not observed in a confined area.	Identify a dedicated entrance and exit to the play park and provide signage to both.
