Debut album from upcoming artist out on March 16, 2023!

Camilla Kramer sends her debut album 'Collateral Damage' out on March 16, 2023 and is already now releasing three singles: All I've got, Run away and Collateral damage.

With catchy melodies and strong lyrics, the audience is led into a melancholic pop universe with a delicious rock twist. The songs revolve around the darkest corners of life and are tales of pain and agony but also stories about strength and hope. With a past marked by anxiety, depression, self-harm and hospitalization, Camilla shares her innermost thoughts and experiences and hope they can inspire and help others.

A meeting with the American singer and musician, Beth Hart, became a turning point and the start of pursuing a lifelong dream: sharing her music with the world. Camilla has always wavered in her belief in herself. Beth Hart did not. The two developed a very special bond and Beth Hart has since become a much-valued friend and mentor. The debut album is also dedicated to Beth. Camilla has previously warmed up for Beth Hart in Amager Bio in Copenhagen, and the chance to warm up on a European tour later this year is in its planning phase.

The album was recorded at Medley Studios in Copenhagen in collaboration with musician and producer Lars Rahbek Andresen, and Peter Kvist Christiansen, guitarist and co-writer, as well as some of Denmark's best musicians. Including Thomas Duus (Love Shop), Jesper Haugaard (Kim Larsen & Kjukken), Knud Møller (Johnny Madsen Band), Søren Andersen (Glenn Hughes, Electric Guitars), Morten Lundsgaard (BAAL) and Lars Rahbek Andresen (Chasing Grace).
