

what to expect 'day to day'

supporting your subject choices

At Cantonian, you will pick at least three subjects from a range of academic and vocational gualifications. Our dedicated Sixth Form staff and the school's Careers Advisor will guide you through your subject choices to ensure that they suit your individual career aspirations.

Learning is led by excellent and inspiring teachers who encouraged to take increased personal responsibility and to develop an appetite for self-motivated, independent study.

dedicated student support

Your Form Tutor will meet with you regularly to provide you with a range of support during your time in the Sixth Form. This will include academic support, reviewing your progress to ensure that you stay on track and achieve your target grades. They will also provide you with pastoral support, prioritising your wellbeing and helping you to achieve a successful work/life balance.







extra-curricular activities

We have designated Sixth Form study and social areas where you are able to undertake independent learning or relax outside of lessons. There is also an opportunity to get involved in a range of activities, such as community projects or supporting our younger pupils, to assist in the development of your own personal skills and qualities and help prepare you for life after Sixth Form.

careers advice and planning

We have a school-based Careers Advisor who is on hand to provide you with specialist advice on your career planning and a team of staff available to help you with your UCAS applications and personal statements. We also provide you with range of opportunities outside of school, such as visits to universities and businesses and a careers fair to enable you to engage with local industry.

what could you study?

We offer a broad range of both academic and vocational courses to suit all abilities.

You will follow an extensive curriculum which is personalised to meet your individual needs. Experienced staff are on hand to help you select the subjects you would like to study and will be most beneficial to your future career and university ambitions.

Advanced Level courses (A Levels)

These courses are studied for two years and are examined at the end of Year 13.

Level 3 Applied BTEC courses

These courses are also studied over two years. Applied BTEC courses suit students who might prefer a different mode of assessment as most still have a greater element of coursework alongside exams.
