CAVRA receives grant from Comic Relief

The Civil Aid Voluntary Rescue Association (CAVRA) has received a grant of £210.70 from the GVS (Comic Relief) Grant Fund.

The scheme that is run by Comic Relief is administered by Glamorgan Voluntary Services (GVS).

The grant was for 60 FP3 Face masks to safeguard it's team members during the current COVID Pandemic, as their work could bring them into close contact with people who have, or may carry the virus.

This is particularly important in any water or flood rescue activities that they may be involved in, together with any transportation of people during adverse weather, such as snow or floods during the forthcoming winter months.

The team have already obtained full face visors, which, are usable with their water rescue kit including dry suits, helmets, gloves and sanitiser.

This gives them the best protection available as well as safeguarding members of the Public.

We believe that this will give us Level 3 protection as outlined in the UKSAR COVID-19 guidance document, which, currently is only available to the Emergency Services, NHS and Helicopter crews.
