

DANISH HUSSARS 1801 - 1814 - (OFFICERS)

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OFFICER 1801 (From painting by C. A. Lorentsen:  
"Slaget på Rheden" ("Battle of Copenhagen 1801),  
Frederiksborg Slot.

SHAKO: Black, Plume: white, Laces: silver, Plate:  
silver with red center, Cords and flounders:  
gold.

DOLMAN: Light blue, Collar and cuffs: crimson,  
Laces and buttons: silver, Sash: crimson with  
barrels in silver, Pouch-belt: silver.

PELISSE: Crimson, Fur: black, Laces and buttons: silver.

PANTALOONS: Light yellow, Waist-belt: crimson,

SABRETACHE: (Rear): Brown leather.

SABRE: Silver with black leather, Sword knot: gold  
with crimson stripes.

BOOTS: Black with laces and tassels in silver.

MAJOR 1803 (From a contemporary painting by C. A. Lorentsen  
located at the Hussar Barracks, Næstved)

Same colours as for the 1801 officer except:

WAIST BELT: Crimson with silver decorations.

DISTINCTIONS: Rank distinctions - on the sleeves of the  
pelisse - gold.

OFFICER INWALKING-OUT DRESS 1812

(From a contemporary painting, Kunstindustri-  
museet.)

HAT: Black, Plume: white, Tassels: gold.

COAT: Crimson, Collar: light blue, Piping: light yellow,  
Buttons and epaulettes: silver.

WAISTCOAT: Light blue, Laces and buttons: silver.

PANTALOONS: Light yellow.

BOOTS: Black with laces and tassels in silver.

OFFICER 1813-14 (From the Danish Auxilliary Corps in  
Northern Germany 1813-14)

Same colours as for the 1803 major except:

TROUSERS: Dark blue with a crimson stripe.

SABRETACHE: Light blue with silver decorations.

SHABRAQUE: Crimson with silver decorations.

HARNESS: Black decorated with white shells.  
Metal: white.

ESTANDART Crimson with gold decorations,  
Fringes: silver.
