

DANISH BOSNIAKS AND ULANS/LANCERS - (OFFICERS) - 1791-1808

BOSNIAK 1791  
Officer, winter

From a contemporary drawing in the State Archives, Copenhagen.

- HAT: Red with white turban - Plume: light blue  
Halfmoon: silver.
- COAT: Red with silver laces.
- JACKET: Light blue - Collar and cuffs: red with silver laces.
- BANDOLEER: Silver.
- TROUSERS: Light blue with silver laces.
- GLOVES: Paille (light yellow).
- SWORD KNOT: Gold with crimson stripes.
- BOOTS: Black.

ULAN OFFICER 1808

From a contemporary drawing in the State Archives, Copenhagen.

Same colours as for the Bosniak 1791 except:

- CZAPSKA: Black leather - Top: crimson - Laces: silver  
Cords and tassels: gold - Cockade: black.  
Plume: crimson with light blue top.
- JACKET: Light blue - Collar, cuffs and lapels:  
crimson - Buttons and laces: silver.
- BANDOLEER: Silver between two crimson laces.
- POUCH: Crimson with silver decorations.
- SASH: Crimson with silver laces and tassels.
- LANCE: Crimson/light blue.
- LANCE PENNON: Crimson/light blue.
- SHABRAQUE: Crimson with silver laces.
- HARNESS: Black leather - Metal: white.

BOSNIAK 1791:  
Officer, summer

Same colours as for the 1791 winter uniform except:

- SASH: Crimson with silver laces.
- WAIST BELT: White.

BOSNIAK 1805:  
Officer

Same colours as for the 1791 uniform except:

- CZAPSKA: Black fur - Top: crimson - Bands: light blue - Cords and tassels: mixed silver/crimson.
- POUCH: Crimson with silver decorations.
