

Full dress uniform (rød galla) NCOs and privates. Part 2.



Head dress: Kepi same shape for all ranks, with white horse hair plume (svejf).

Pelisse: Same shape as for officers, but the colour is scarlet, it is edged with black Astrakhan fur, the breast ornamentation is densely mounted fabric leash, as is the rest of the ornamentation.

Hussar tunic: Blue fabric not as fine as the one used for officers, the blue colour is slightly darker than for officers. The tunic has five hussar loops on the breast and ornamentation on the rear side. On the sleeves Austrian knots, and shoulder straps all in white fabric leash.

Hussar breeches: Same colour fabric as the tunic. Along the outer seam is a white leash.

Riding boots: Black with white upper edge with a knot at the front. Spurs are worn.

Sabretache: Same size and form as for officers, but all ornamentation in white fabric, carried in three white leather straps.

Sabre: All white metal, scabbard with only one ring for carrying it by the fourth (front) leather strap. Sabre knot black leather.
