






Uniforms from different times.



This picture also shows dragoons (to the right) - the second type of cavalry, which formed a part of the Danish army in the period up to WWI. (Picture from a children's book)




Uniforms of hussars and dragoons ca. 1910

Toy soldiers 5 cm; type" Brigader" made in Denmark from 1946 to 1977.




"Brigader" figures and a single"Tradition" figure.
