Government planning to remove fracking from planning process – it was in Tory manifesto

All very worrying

Clearly Colin's brief is more "local" than "world" development but fracking is an issue within the climate change debate. Perhaps Chester Friends of Earth take a lead and we could support or possibly Frack Free Dee Re change in cost of subs: for individuals JT suggested £5.00 waged and free to unwaged. TG expressed concern about whether there would be enough money to pay for big event next year if subs were reduced. To give plenty of time for planning it was suggested we organise a major event in October to celebrate
