# Minutes of Committee Meeting held on Monday 2 December 2019 at Annie's

Welcome: TG chaired the meeting Present: TG, LC, JT, GG, VJ, BP and AM

#### 2 Minutes and matters arising:

- Committee 4.11.19:
  - > JT produced background notes re Natalia and sent them to BP as requested
  - > BP not yet contacted Iain Taylor.
  - Meeting re revising CWDF's leaflet to be arranged after next committee meeting
  - AM has requested more cards on issue of ISDS from Traidcraft but had no reply
  - JT has sent round information on buying shares in Chester Community Energy
  - > BP has spoken to Ken Walker re Hustings.
  - > AM not yet spoken to SB about Robin Roth (SB not well at present)
- Forum 12-11-19: 2 issues discussed careful wording in the minutes on the issue of the Conference on Palestine organised by Joseph O'Neill (as requested by Katy Rowe) and discussion about how best to present Natalia's talk. Both issues resolved

#### 3 Finance & administration issues, including:

- Last statement was from 31 October, and gave bank balance as £278.56, plus cash in hand of £26.10 >> £304.66, which I reported to the last Forum meeting. Transactions: Cheques written for £10 to FoE, £30 to CHAWREC; AM cash expenses paid £2.98; November Forum collection £3.44; £5 (cash) received from FTSG; £20 paid in to bank >> £258.56 in the account + £11.56 cash-in-hand = £270.12.
- The issue with CHAWREC July cheque payment is still unresolved, although I
  again raised it with Valerie and she promised to contact Anita but no followup/feedback yet received
- JT has asked about a possible payment to CAT to thank them for Jane Fisher's lecture ...
- JT had request for City of Sanctuary to join CWDF. TG will send City of Sanctuary email address to BP so BP can send subs form

• Sustainable Chester Winter Fair 23-11-19: steady flow of people throughout the day. 18 new names on our contacts list. Map that VJ had organised was a very good idea. BP has contacted the people on list and referred to GDPR but so far only had 1 reply but are covered by clause which was at bottom of sheet. Now more people signed up after CAT talk. BP has circulated CAT PDF to those who signed up. Had 1 non-delivery from email to Paul Bowers. LC will try and find out why find out more. Committee feel that this would be too difficult to organise on our own but could maybe enlist the support of other groups such as CWaC, Eco Communities, CSF, Reaseheath, Christian Dunn, Cheshire farmers, George Mombiot
