2 Minutes and matters arising:

4 Finance update and membership:

Our latest bank statement shows our balance as £351.56 on 30 September, which includes a subscription deposit paid in early in August and the money paid in directly by Bernie Draper. JT paid DEC £50 as our tribute to Colin Watson, but the £30 donation by cheque which he gave to CHAWREC does not appear to have been processed, which will eventually reduce our balance to £321.56.

We also have a float of petty cash, £21.04, giving us an effective total of £342.60. We have not yet been invoiced by Mike Roberts for hosting our website – last year we paid him around £40.

Thanks to Vicki, JT now has a good supply of envelopes to enable him to pay money in to our account via my local Post Office, which will be necessary when the Co-op bank branch in Chester closes at the end of Nov.

The last membership renewal payment was from Bernie Draper on 18 August, so JT has updated the file which was sent round to committee. Unlikely that we will receive any further subscription payments for 2020.
