3 Finance update:

From our last bank statement, on 30 July we had £523.44. Since then, we paid £200 to the Haiti Disaster Appeal via MSF, £5 to top up our petty cash, £41.25 to Michael Roberts for web hosting, and £71.75 to Bell Graphics for printing off 1,000 copies of our new leaflet >> £205.44.

JT paid AM's expenses of £1.76 from petty cash, reducing it from £3.03 to £1.27, but the £5 top-up >> £6.27, so our net worth is £211.71.

If we hold 3 more meetings at CHAWREC during the remainder of the year, this will reduce by $\pounds 90 \gg \pounds 121.71$, so collection of outstanding 2021 subscriptions would be very helpful to our finances.

The not-yet-paid members who subscribed in 2020 are: CAFOD; CAMCC; Chester Fair Trading; Holy Trinity Blacon; Our Lady's Justice & Peace Group. This represents a potential total income of £75 if they can all be persuaded to renew their subscriptions. JT will take a cheque in to the Unity Centre for room hire on 14th Sept
