



Why can non care experienced people say brothers and sisters but we aren't allowed to say that in a formal setting?


Togetherness

# Better words to use


Meet-up? It's up to the young person on what they find comfortable. Gathering or get together. Something that doesn't make it sound so intimidating.

Care experienced meeting


You call it my meeting , but is it ? I think it is for you
