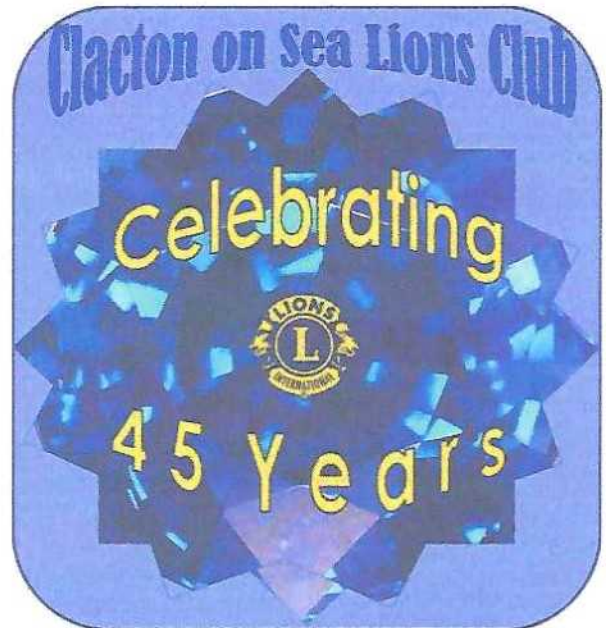


# CLACTON LIONS CRIER

Clacton on Sea Lions Club (CIO) was formed in 1979 and became a Charitable Incorporated Organisation registered with the Charity Commission in 2019. We are part of Lions International which is the largest service organisation in the world with around 1.4 million members in 210 countries or geographical areas.

Despite our name, our Club serves the whole of the Tendring District providing a range of fundraising; service and social activities – raising funds and providing service to help those in need within our area and beyond.



## During the year ended 30th June 2024 our members and helpers have:

Volunteered **4,344** hours in service  
to our local and wider communities

Taken part in at least  
**298** separate service activities across the year

Served over **28,119** individuals in our local  
and wider communities

Donated **£28,247** to good causes  
in our local area and further afield

Service Activities this year have included recycling over 58,000 pairs of spectacles plus 490 hearing aids; 4,400 small printer ink cartridges and 750 mobile phones\*.
