- You are available for a full-time (up to 37 hours a week) intern position.
- You are interested in the environmental and cleantech sector.
- You have strong communication skills and are fluent in English and Danish.
- You have experience with presentations, marketing material, etc., and are skilled in PowerPoint, WordPress, etc. (not a must).

- An exciting job in a dynamic and internationally focused organization with highly skilled colleagues based in Copenhagen, Aarhus, Odense, Roskilde (DTU Risø), or Sønderborg.
- Invaluable project managing experience and in-depth understanding of the cleantech clusters and sector, where you develop valuable network connections.
- Up to 37 hours per week (depending on your studies, etc.) – ideally, the internship duration is 4-6 months.
