### 4. Headteacher's Report

6th formers are becoming more involved in the house teams. C-L will try to locate the house badges in the PA cupboard.

Visit from southwest 100 - the 'Reach Foundation' are investing heavily with multi academy trusts, they visit what they consider to be to best run schools in the country of which we are one of them. They meet the year 12 students and are re visiting again next week. TH does not feel it is right for CGS to join a MAT but is happy to support and work with school in Devon.

TH is looking at developing a 'Development board' to aid this support given. CGS is also a teaching hub and hub for training new teachers from 2024. The PGC will come from Nottingham for this. The school are looking at how they can help lower attending children in school to achieve more.

TH has expressed that the development board will look at how the funds that are raised by the PA is best spent. C-L said it will be great to have a goal and fundraise for a specific project.

TH expressed that Take 5 needs a refurbishment and there are areas within the school that require improvements. They are also looking at the car parking area. The 'Development Board' would also look at this. TH said that more classrooms are required and the general expansion of the school as it goes as a teaching school / hub.

TH is very ambitious about the school and is keen to see the progression and how they can make a difference including change.

C-L expressed that the PA are keen to have a goal to fundraise for.

Industrial action, please see the e-mail sent out today 28th/08/23. The school are doing their best to keep the school open as much as possible.

Recruitment requirement for next year is minimal, which is great news for the school.
