Welcome to Community Ed Academy!

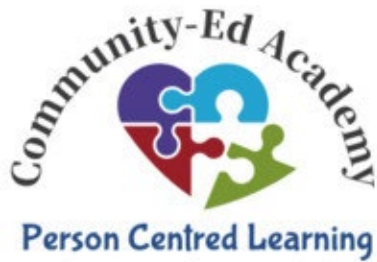
