CONNECTING WITH THE NEXT GENERATION

Council of Mosques in partnership with Tower Hamlets Council have organised an event called "Connecting with the Next Generation".

ADDRESSING MISCONCEPTIONS ABOUT ISLAM

A workshop on addressing misconception on Islam was held in June 2014 at the Kingsley Hall Community Centre. The event was organised by Council of Mosques and supported by Poplar HARCA . Local residents from various faith groups and officers from Poplar HARCA were invited to attend the workshop. Chair of Tower Hamlets Interfaith Forum Rev Alan Green were also invited to attend and participate.

The aim of the workshop was to:

- Answer questions about Islam
- Clarify common misconceptions
- Build bridges and improve community cohesion





The Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) and the Independent Safeguarding Authority (ISA) have merged to become the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS).

CRB checks are now called DBS checks.

A DBS check may be needed for:

- Certain jobs or voluntary work, e.g. working with children or in health care
- Applying to foster or adopt a child
- Council of Mosques in partnership with Tower Hamlets Council can support and check Identification for DBS application forms.
- In July 2014 we have supported three members of Hindgrove Cultural and Community Association to apply for DBS check.
- Council of Mosques welcomes any members to receive support from us to apply for DBS checks.
