

Happy New Year to all of you!

Since the previous newsletter more than 208 patients have been randomised, and we have now randomised 1655 patients (49%). Thirty sites in five countries are active.

Future active sites

Herlev Hospital will be joining the trial in February. UK and Italian sites are awaiting the final national approvals.

Important information

- **IMPORTANT:** we are closing in on the 1675 included patients (50%). We kindly ask you to complete data registration of all patients, including 90-day follow-up to prepare for the first interim analysis (90 days after 50% of patients included). Following completion of data registration, the remaining part of the case-money will be transferred.
- An update of the Danish procedures relating to participant consent will be implemented january 16th, as previously outlined.
- An investigator meeting for Danish trial sites has been planned to be held at the Danish Intensive Care Symposium at Hindsgavl Castle, january 27th.
