

Since the previous newsletter almost 100 patients have been randomised, and we have now randomised 335 patients (10%). Sixteen sites in two countries are active. Well done and thanks to all of you for the great effort.

In April Finland started recruiting patients as the first country outside Denmark. Welcome to the following Finnish sites: Kuopio, Turku and Helsinki. Furthermore, five Danish sites have started recruiting patients. Welcome to the hospitals in Viborg, Hillerød, Hjørring, Herning and Slagelse.

Kuopio has had a very good start and was not only the top recruiter in Finland but also among the top 10 recruiters of the month.

Please remember to screen all patients <u>fulfilling the inclusion criteria</u> in the electronic case report form (eCRF) even if you know that one or more exclusion criteria is met, as this information is needed in the CONSORT diagram in the manuscript to come.
