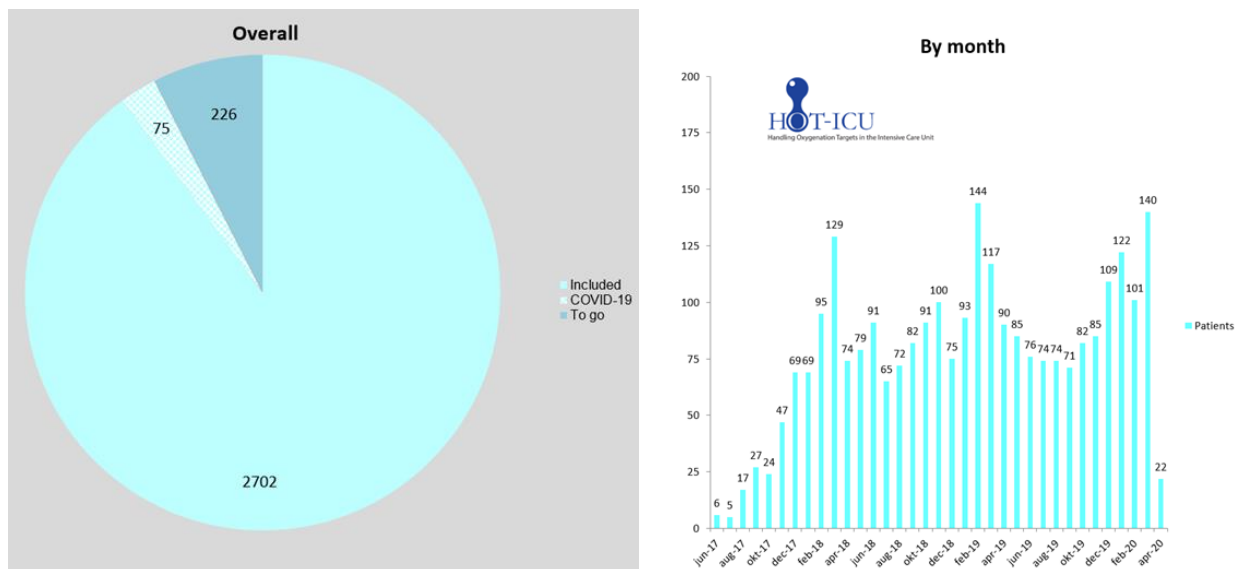
HOT-ICU newsletter – April 2020

Thank you very much for your steady commitment to the HOT-ICU trial.

Status

By mid-March we started registering all COVID-19 positive cases, and since then 75 patients have been enrolled.

Currently, 2702 of the planned 2928 patients have been included. With 45 inclusions in week 13 this marked a new record for one week! March 2020 produced the second highest number of inclusions with 140 in total.



Viborg recruited patient number 2628 the 23rd of March marking the remaining 300 patients in the trial. For this effort they have received an award. Congratulations to the site!

The site that includes patient number 2728 will likewise be rewarded.
