Thank you very much for your steady commitment to the HOT-ICU trial.

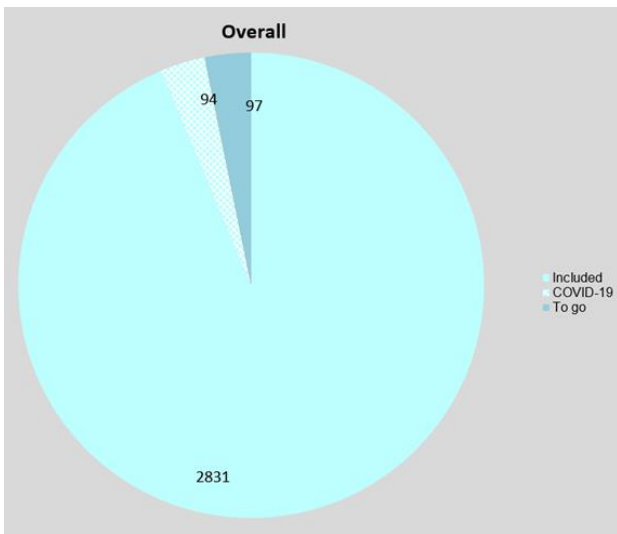
### Status
