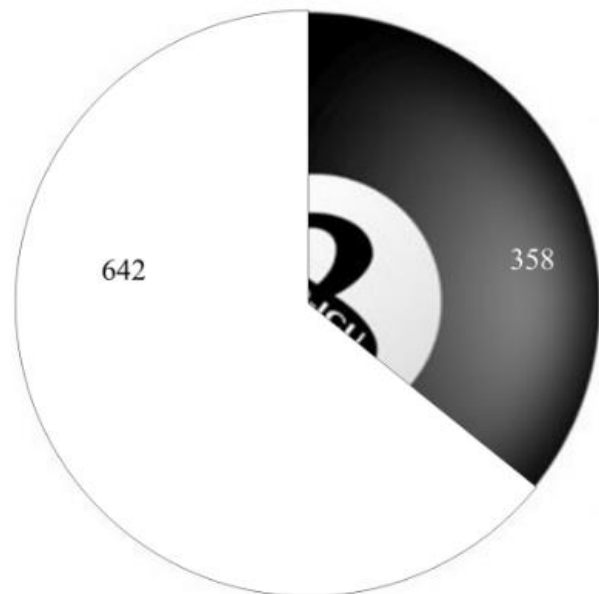
Dear Friends! Thank you for your commitment to the AID-ICU trial!

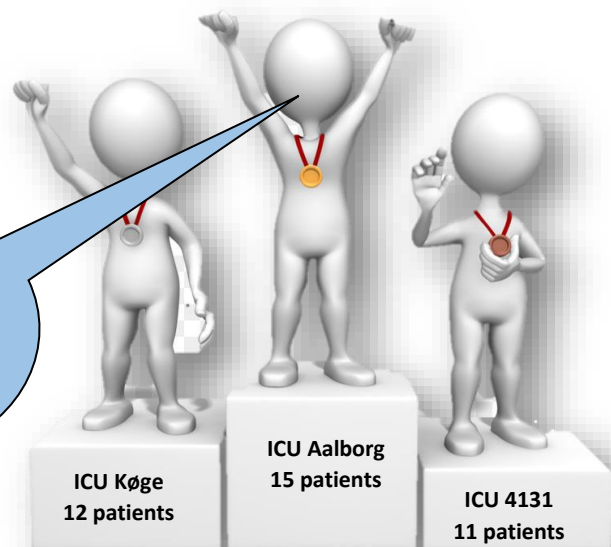

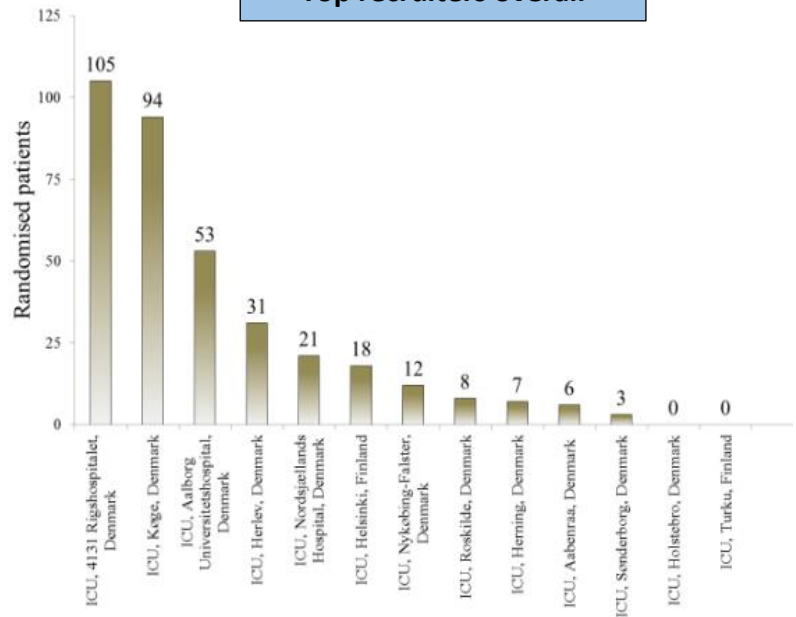
Welcoming new sites
