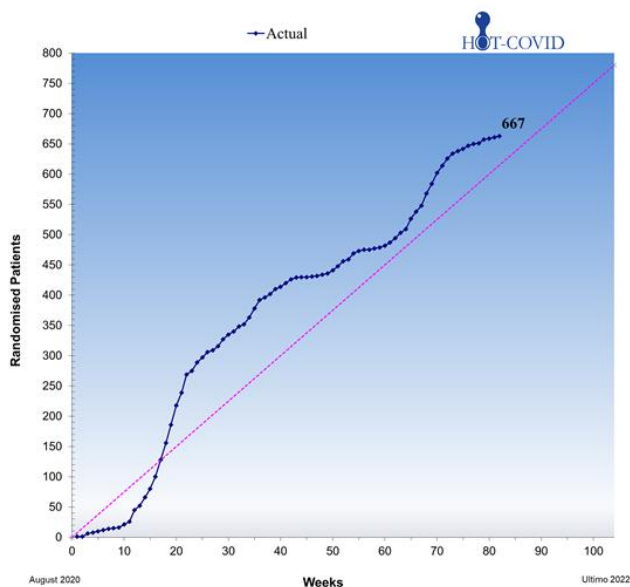
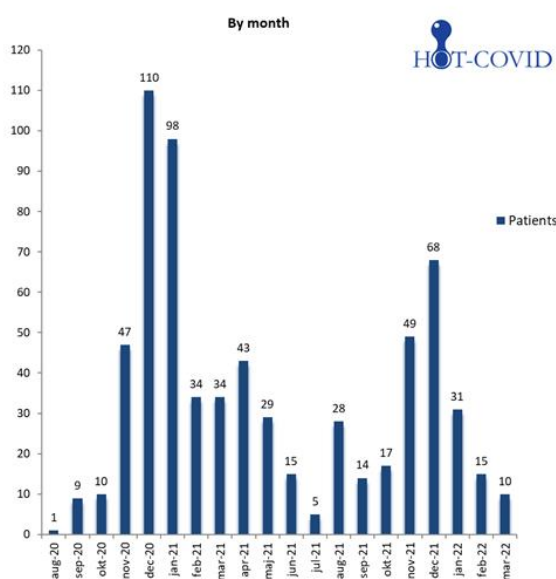
Status

The rate of COVID-19 hospital and ICU admissions continue to decrease reflecting the development of the pandemic. The trial remains on-going, and we expect to randomise the last patient ultimo 2022.

Please note that the annual safety report for 2021 and the updated trial approval from the Danish Medicines Agency has been uploaded to the webpage. Both should be downloaded and put into your site master files.

Recruitment

12 patients were randomised in March 2022 and we are grateful for every single randomisation. Currently 669 patients have been randomised with only 111 patients to go. We expect low recruitment rates in the coming months, and therefore implore all of you to screen and randomise all relevant patients.
