## AID-ICU newsletter – June/July/August 2021

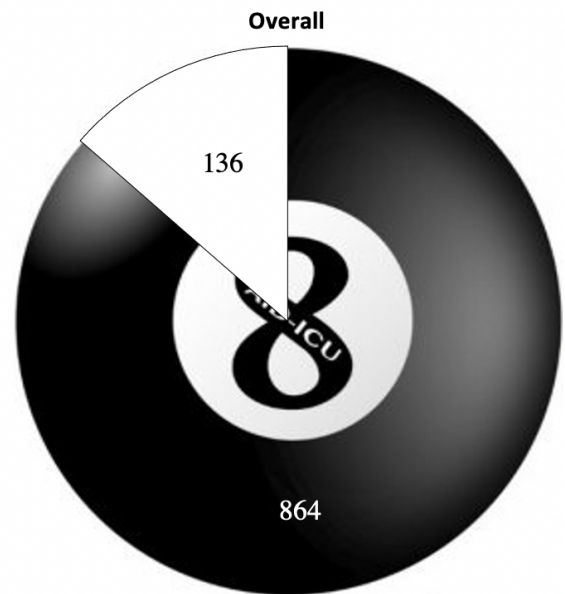
Thank you for your commitment to the AID-ICU trial!

### STATUS

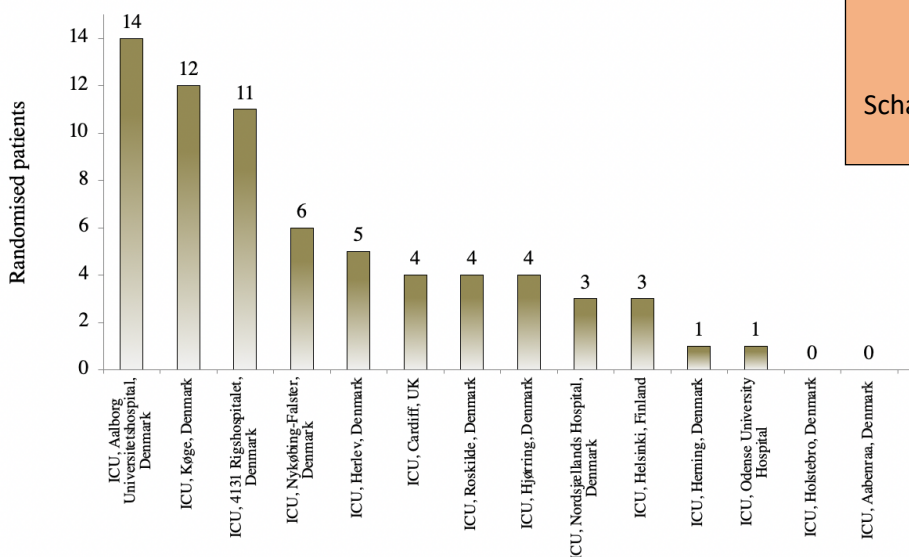
Recruitment has been going well the last couple of weeks and we have now less than 15% of the trial population to go! This progress will ensure finalization of the study in the beginning of 2022 – thanks to all of you. A special thanks to ICU Aalborg and Cardiff ICU who have significantly improved their recruitment in the last period. Keep up the good work and we will soon be able to improve evidence and outcomes for critically ill patients suffering from delirium!

### Trial sites

No more trial sites will join us at this final stages of the trial. We have started the progress of closing sites with low recruitment and expired trial medication. The following sites have terminated their recruitment; ICU Monza, ICU Aabenraa, ICU Sønderjylland and ICU Holstebro. Thank you for all the work you have put into the AID-ICU trial.



### Top Recruiters in June, July and August (combined)

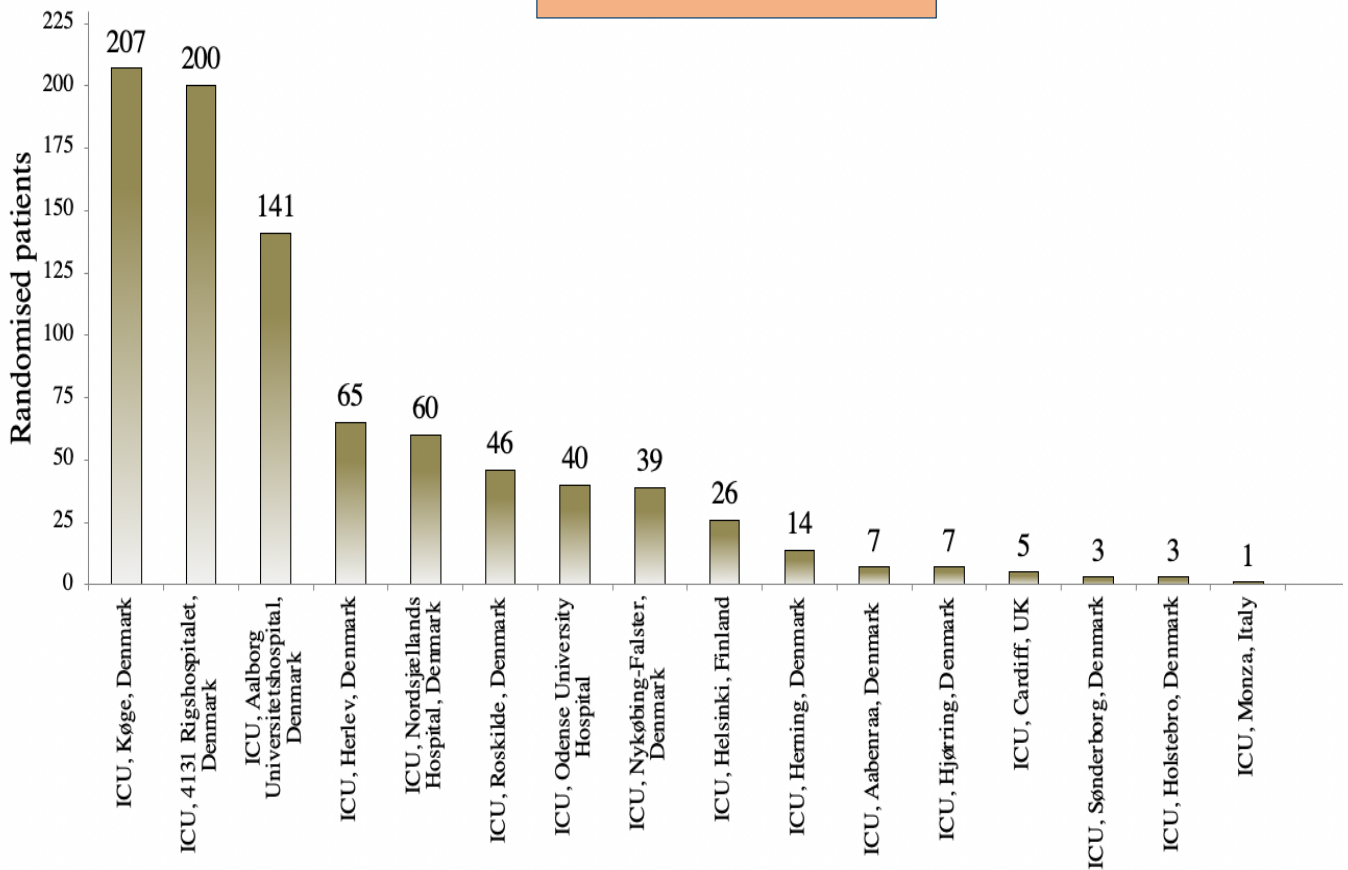

### Other important news from the coordinating centre

1. Co-enrolment REVIVAL  
The application for co-enrolment in REVIVAL has been submitted and we are expecting an approval. However, NO co-enrolment with REVIVAL can take place until we get a formal approval from REVIVAL Trial Steering Committee. The coordinating investigator will inform you as soon as we get this.
2. Please strive to keep protocol compliance, we have had an unfortunate increase in protocol violations due to open-label antipsychotics. It is very important to manage delirium with trial medication followed by escape medication when trial medication is insufficient for safe delirium management. 3. Please ensure that email notifications of warnings and major protocol violations are handled to secure adherence to the protocol.
