Happy New Year to all collaborators!!

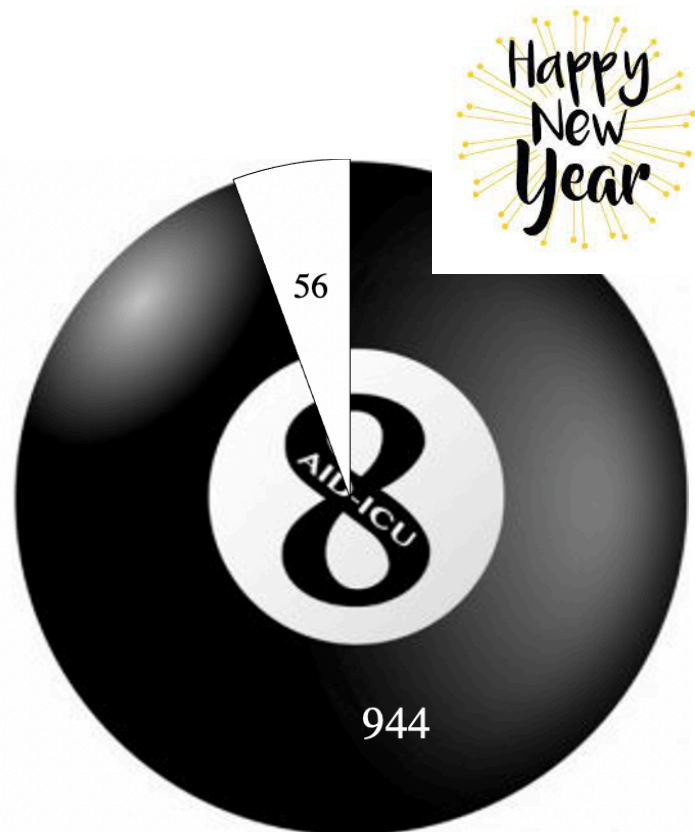
STATUS

Other important news from the coordinating centre

1. Please check your trial medication. All expired medication should be discarded. Remember to fill-in disposal form and forward it to the coordinating investigator: ncan@regionsjaelland.dk.
2. Please strive to keep protocol compliance, we have had an unfortunate increase in protocol violations due to open-label antipsychotics. It is very important to manage delirium with trial medication followed by escape medication when trial medication is insufficient for safe delirium management. Please check SOP Trial medication (<http://www.cric.nu/aid-icu-sop-trial-medication/>).
3. Please ensure that email notifications of warnings and major protocol violations are handled to secure adherence to the protocol.
