
Please be aware of this when transferring patients to other sites. And last but not least – hang in there only 56 patients to go!



- 1. Please check your trial medication. All expired medication should be discarded. Remember to fill-in disposal form and forward it to the coordinating investigator: ncan@regionsjaelland.dk.
- Please strive to keep protocol compliance, we have had an unfortunate increase in protocol violations due to open-label antipsychotics. It is very important to manage delirium with trial medication followed by escape medication when trial medication is insufficient for safe delirium management. - 3. Please ensure that email notifications of warnings and major protocol violations are handled to secure adherence to the protocol.
