CONDITIONS AND COMPETITION RULES

Accommodation & meals during the tournament (max. 13 boxers + 2 coaches + 1 medical)

In single roomIn twin room103 €/person/day73 €/person/day

o In triple room 63 €/person/day (2 beds + extra bed from the sofa)

Accommodation & meals during the tournament for one AIBA 3*/2*/1* R&J

o In single room 70 €/person/day

Accommodation & meals during the tournament for additional persons

In single roomIn twin room120 €/person/day100€ /person/day

Accommodation & meals for teams arriving before the 20th or leaving after the 24th of January

In single room
In twin or triple room
120 €/person/day with breakfast only
100€/person/day with breakfast only

No other meals than breakfast are provided for teams with early arrival or late departure. The price is valid for the extra nights, otherwise the regular prices.

- The LOC provides:
 - o transportation from/to Tampere airport, railway/bus station upon arrival/departure
 - o transportation from /to Helsinki airport upon arrival/departure <u>for an extra fee of 40€/person/return trip</u>
 - o local transportation during the tournament between the hotel and the venue
 - training facilities
 - o tournament awards (gold, silver, bronze medals, special awards, gifts for 1st and 2nd place)
- European boxers must have the European Health Insurance Card with them in case of medical services needed. The organizer does not provide medical insurance.
- Travel costs to Tampere and back home are the responsibility of the participating team.

All teams must pay the accommodation fee by bank transfer in advance. Team Delegations will not be able to receive accreditation cards and hotel rooms before the payment has been fully made. Only in special circumstances the payment can be done upon arrival by card or cash in EURO – in this case it must be agreed separately in advance with the LOC.



COMPOSITION OF THE OFFICIAL DELEGATION

- Each participating association may bring one boxer in each weight category.
- Official delegation: max. 13 boxers, 2 coaches, 1 medical doctor and one AIBA Star-qualified referee/judge.
- Teams with less than 3 boxers, may not include more officials than boxers.
- Each participating team should bring AIBA Star-qualified referee/judge. For teams with three or more boxers, referee/judge is mandatory.
- Additional people outside the official delegation are charged extra fee for their accommodation.
- Teams that arrive prior to the official arrival date or leave after the official departure date are charged extra fee for their accommodation.

COMPETITION RULES

- The tournament will be carried out in 11 men and 2 women elite weight categories:
 - Men 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63,5kg, 67kg, 71kg, 75kg, 80kg, 86kg, 92kg and +92kg.
 - Women 50kg and 57kg.
 - The LOC reserves the right to change the women categories to be boxed in Round Robin format if there is 4 or less boxers by category.
- The participants must have equipment according to the AIBA rules:
 - Boxers must bring two sets of uniform with colors according to the AIBA rules.
 - Gumshield, footwear, bandages/handwraps, protectors.
 - An up-to-date record book with annual medicals completed and AIBA Medical Certificate.
- Bouts consist of 3 rounds, 3 minutes each. AIBA 10 Point Must-Scoring System will be used.
- Delegations can participate in the tournament only by fulfilling the conditions set in this invitation.



COVID-19 REGULATIONS

All members of the Team Delegations are obligated to:

Before travelling:

Register to FINENTRY service online: https://www.finentry.fi/

Present on arrival:

- a) an individual COVID-19 original medical certificate (PCR test made within 72 hours before arrival) with a negative result. The certificate must be in English **OR**
- b) an individual original medical certificate to prove the participant has overcome the COVID-19 disease during the last six months **OR**
- c) an individual original certificate of COVID-19 vaccination (fully vaccinated) and the last vaccination dose was given at least 14 days ago in English AND an individual COVID-19 original medical certificate (Antigen test made within 48 hours before arrival)
- an individual Declaration of Absence of COVID-19 symptoms for at least 14 days prior to event arrival day.
- an individual COVID-19 Liability Release Waiver.

On arrival to Finland (airport, harbor, train station, land border):

• Submit to a free PCR test provided by the local authorities.

During the event:

- Always wear a medical face mask (type FFP2 or FFP3 without a valve or type IIR, NO Fabric masks approved) during the event, with exceptions of:
 - boxers during a bout, where it is prohibited.
 - boxers in the warm-up area, where it is optional.
 - participants in their own hotel rooms, where it is optional.
 - participants during their meals ONLY when seated at their dining table.
 - boxers on the medal podium during the medal ceremonies



- Carry accreditation at all times during the event.
- Observe social distancing at all times (2 m), except for boxers during their bouts and during warming up with their coach.
- Not to have any contact with individuals who are not accredited at the event.
- Submit to temperature screening by the LOC and local health authorities at any time during the event.
- Submit to PCR and other COVID-19 testing at any time during the event on request of the LOC.

NOTE! These regulations may change due to government or health authorities' rules and/or national laws.

COVID-19 Managers and/or local health authorities:

- Follow all instructions of LOC COVID-19 Event Managers, including isolation, quarantine, observation procedures and contact tracing in case of need.
- Timely report all COVID-19 protocol violations during the event to LOC COVID-19 Managers
- In addition to the individual obligations, participating Team Delegations must:
 - Appoint a COVID-19 contact person from the official Team Delegation list, who will be present during the event and will be in charge of any COVID-19 related issues for their Team Delegation.
 - Ensure none of the Team Delegation members, including R&Js, do not have serious underlying health conditions known to increase the risk of lethal outcomes from COVID-19.
 - There will be no mandatory quarantine periods for Team Delegations in the event provided there is no positive COVID-19 test result or exposure to the virus.
