INVITATION INTERNATIONAL 2 DAY OPEN TOURNAMENT TO ALL WORLD BOXING FEDERATION



The Czech Boxing Association invites you to the INTERNATIONAL OPEN BOXING TOURNAMENT in the Prague, The Czech Republic from 11th to 12th May 2024

Purpose of this competition is to develop boxers from World Boxing national federations at all levels. This 2 day competition is open to all boxers with minimum 5 bouts, but also for experienced boxers in all age categories.

The final draw will be done by the pool of all the Coaches on Saturday May 11 using the seeding to match up boxers with competitive boxing experiences and skills to maximalize number of the bouts for all participating boxers. Both coaches must always confirm the draw in case of seeding.

Even losers can compete second day.

It is a club level competition, but you can also send your national team level boxers representing you're his club, especially in younger age categories. Please be honest when registering your boxers to fill in number of bouts boxed. It is not about victory/looses it is about developing World Boxing boxers.

All Boxers can box only one bout per day.

3) Competition rules

A. Record book, annual medical certification

Participants must bring record book of respective national federation with annual medicals up to date, current and valid passport, two sets of uniform

B. Insurance

The LOC does not provide insurance, all participants must get their own travel and medical insurance

C. Gloves & headgear

Boxers must have their own 10OZ, 12OZ gloves. Professional bandages are not allowed. 10oz gloves will be used for School and Junior age categories, from Youth and Elite (51 kg.) to Welterweight (67 kg.)

12oz gloves will be used from the Youth and Elite Lightmiddleweight category (71 kg.) to the Super Heavyweight category (+92 kg.)

All participants who should wear headgear according to World Boxing Competition Rules must bring their own headgear and other protectors (gumshield, groin protector).

D. Bandages

Each participating boxer must bring their own Velcro bandages.

Professional hand wraps will not be permitted.

Referees & Judges

All National officials are welcomed. Participating delegation should send their official at own expense. No Per Diem will be provided by LOC.

4) Entry fee.

Entry fee for both competition days is 40 EUR (20 EUR per day).

It does not include accommodation, travel and catering. All participating delegations are responsible for their travel cost to the venue and back, as well as accommodation and meals. There are many accommodation options available in Prague or outside the Prague. We recommend to book accommodation as soon as possible, because of the World Ice Hockey Championship in Prague during that time.

5) Preliminary schedule

We expect to have minimum 3 rings, please bring more coaches in case you have more boxers. Coaches do not pay any fee. Only boxers has to pay. The end of the daily program is based on the number of the participant, but could be even in the evening.
