3. COMPETITION RULES & FORMAT

This event will be conducted in accordance with the actual World Boxing Competition Rules.

Age category	Youth, born from 1 January 2007 to 31 December 2008
Men's weight categories	-50kg;-55kg;-60kg;-65kg;-70kg;-75kg;-80kg;-85kg;-90kg;+90kg
Women's weight categories	-48kg;-51kg;-54kg;-57kg;-60kg;-65kg;-70kg;-75kg;-80kg;+80kg
Draw sizes and composition	Max. 16 boxers per weight category, as limited by the number of competition days. Depending on the number of participants, a different competition format may be applied in the corresponding weight classes.
Number of rings	One or two competition rings
Scoring and timing	Swiss Timing system
Boxing equipment	Sting gloves and head guards will be provided by the LOC.
Hand wrapping	Velcro bandages must be used by all participating boxers. Boxers must bring their own Velcro bandages, which are compliant with World Boxing Competition Rules.
Boxing Entries Check	Mandatory for inclusion into the draw

5. ENTRY PROCESS

It is required that respective participating National Federations confirm the technical and medical standard of the boxers and other Team Members. Participating National Federations are also responsible for submitting the personal data on behalf of each member of their Team, and for ensuring that the personal information provided during the entry process is accurate. At this time, the entry process for Teams is completed via email, as specified in the table below:

Entering reserve boxers is strongly encouraged to allow for substitutions after the entry deadline prior to the Boxing Entries Check without penalties.

It is **mandatory** for all participating National Federations with three or more participating boxers to delegate a World Boxing certified Referee and Judge as a part of their Teams.

Each participating National Federation can enter the following number of Team Members in the official Delegation to accompany the boxers:

It is the responsibility of participating National Federations to ensure that all Team Members are qualified to perform their duties.

5.1. Boxing Entries Check

The Boxing Entries check is the final part of the event entry process. The LOC will inform Teams of their exact appointment time prior to the event as well as it will be displayed on the Team information board.

The Boxing Entries Check is mandatory for all Teams, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to arrive timely for their respective appointment.

Each Team may appoint a maximum of two people to attend its Boxing Entries Check (e.g. Team Leader and the Team Doctor).

In order to be cleared for the competition, Teams must provide the following documents for each boxer, signed and completed as required:

- Copy of passport
- Record Book (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months)
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy Form (girls boxers only), signed by the boxers legal guardian
- Uniforms (red and blue) per World Boxing Competition Rules

To complete the Boxing Entries process and receive accreditations, Teams must have fully settled their accommodation costs with the LOC.

6. VISA & ENTRY TO THE HOST COUNTRY

German Boxing Association will provide assistance to participating National Federations requiring Visas but cannot guarantee their acquisition.

For information and visa support letters, please complete visa information form and email via b.bastian@boxverband.de. The deadline to submit requests for visa support letters is 30 May 2025 (23:59 CET).

It is the responsibility of participating National Federations to ensure that their Teams respect the conditions of stay defined by the Government of the country hosting the event. If any participant does not respect these conditions, any costs arising will be borne by the respective National Federation.

7. INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION

The designated airport for arrival and departure of Teams is **Berlin International Airport (BER)**.

Every Team will be picked up only once. If the team doesn't come together, the first members of the Team will have to wait for the rest of the delegation.

All Teams must submit their arrival and departure details to the LOC via b.bastian@boxverband.de by 8 July 2025 (23:59 CET).

8. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

The LOC will provide airport transfers and ground transportation for Teams.

Additional transportation costs will apply when airport transfers or any other transportation is required outside of event days and costings will be sought on request.

All Teams must submit their accommodation request and rooming list to the LOC via b.bastian@boxverband.de by 1 July 2025. (23:59 CET).

9.1 Costs: For every person (athletes, officials, and staff) you have to pay in twin room a fee of 80.00 EUR per day and person for accommodation and 3 meals per day and single room rate is 100.00 EUR (limited capacity).

Prices include breakfast, lunch, and dinner. The first meal provided is evening dinner on the day of your arrival. The last meal provided is the breakfast.

9.2. Payment terms

All Teams must cover costs of their accommodation for the entire Event Period. Accreditations and room keys will not be issued until accommodation has been paid in full to the German Boxing Association.

All Teams must pay the accommodation costs by bank transfer in advance. Only in special circumstances the payment can be done upon arrival by cash in EURO – in this case it must be agreed separately in advance with the German Boxing Association.

All remaining accommodation and transportation costs must be completed **by 22 July 2025**.

10. IMAGE RIGHTS & VIDEO RECORDING

The German Boxing Association will film the event for broadcast, promotional videos and official event photographers will take still images of boxers before and during the event. All sessions will be open to the accredited media. By participating in the event, each Team Member agrees to release his/her image rights to the German Boxing Association.

Video recording of bouts for broadcasting purposes of any kind (including social media) will not be allowed.

National Federations may be allowed to record bouts of their boxers using only one camera exclusively for technical purposes. Specific location in the venue will be reserved for this purpose.

11. MEDICAL SERVICES

The German Boxing Association will provide first aid during the entire event period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the event.

12. ANTI-DOPING

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with World Boxing Anti-Doping Rules and World Anti-Doping Code. According to WADA regulations, blood testing may be conducted during World Boxing Competitions.

13. INSURANCE

All accredited participants must have their own travel, medical, repatriation and liability insurance covering the entire event and travel period.
