# THE PROJECT

Throughout the mobility, we will use non-formal education to transform climate concern into youth-led action. Our goal is to empower young people to become changemakers in their communities by combining hands-on learning with real-life exploration.

Participants will strengthen their understanding of climate issues and the circular economy, while gaining practical knowledge on upcycling, recycling, and effective waste sorting. The project places a strong emphasis on turning learning into local action, supported by partner mentoring and simple, reusable toolkits for youth workers.

By connecting experiential learning with civic engagement, participants will have the opportunity to practice green skills in a safe and intercultural environment. They will co-lead activities and reflect on their experiences, preparing them to apply what they have just learned in their local communities with realistic and accessible support.

Finally, we aim for each participant to adopt at least one new eco-friendly habit upon returning home, share their knowledge with peers, and take on an active civic role in promoting sustainability.



# MAIN OBJECTIVES

- Strengthen participants' environmental literacy and green skills.
- Facilitate peer-to-peer learning across diverse European regions.
- Increase understanding of sustainable development, covering its environmental and social aspects.
- Empower youth to design, lead, and evaluate local sustainability initiatives after the exchange.



- Encourage participants to adopt sustainable practices in daily life.
- Foster inclusion among youngsters with fewer opportunities.
- Serve as a platform to promote sustainable development locally and internationally.

# PARTICIPANT COUNTRIES



In this project, we are welcoming 7 participants (including the group leader) from Cyprus, Greece, Romania, Italy and Denmark. The age of the participants is expected to be between 18-30 years old.

Each national team will have one group leader with no age limit, who will be responsible for their national group, follow-up activities, dissemination and submitting the necessary documents for the reimbursement process.

- You have a genuine desire to learn about sustainability.
- You are curious about other cultures and open to learning from diverse perspectives.

- You speak English at least at a basic level and are eager to improve it.

# PARTICIPANT'S PROFILE



- You are committed to take action in your local community and implement follow-up activities.

- You are willing to disseminate the project's results at local and regional level.

The venue is a spacious holiday home located in Ebeltoft, Denmark's oldest market town. It offers nine cozy bedrooms (4-5 participants per room), each with a private bathroom and TV. A highlight of the house is the swimming pool area with a large jacuzzi accommodating up to six people. Surrounded by natural beauty, the house is just a 12-minute walk from the beach.

# THE VENUE

# FOOD

# TRANSPORT



## Getting to Denmark - flight, bus, train or car?

To get to Denmark, you can either fly to Billund, Aarhus, Aalborg, or Copenhagen Airport. You have to arrive in Denmark latest on **24. September at 17:00**. Otherwise there is a high risk that you will miss the last train/bus to the venue.

Remember to send us an email before booking your flight tickets, as we have to confirm your itinerary and the price of your tickets. Be aware that we do not reimburse tickets purchased through travel agencies (e.g. Skyscanner, Kiwi etc.). Therefore, please book the tickets directly from the airline company's website.

## Would you like to travel around?

If you would like to spend some extra days in Denmark, feel free to do so. You are allowed to spend up to 6 extra days outside the project dates. However, you'll have to cover the expenses for food and accommodation yourself for the extra days.

# TRANSPORT



We encourage you to make use of green travel options for reaching Denmark. Therefore, if you use train and/or bus, your final stop should be **Aarhus Central Station**. From there, we will arrange the transport for you to reach the project venue.

In case you will be travelling by flight, you **MUST** book your flight tickets latest by **1<sup>st</sup> August**. This is very important because we need to buy in advance the local train/bus tickets for you to get to the project venue. Public transport is very expensive in Denmark and that's why we need to book local tickets 4-5 weeks before. Do not book any tickets for regional transport in Denmark, as we will arrange this for you.

If you book your flight tickets after 1<sup>st</sup> August, there is a high risk of going over the travel budget, as the train tickets from Copenhagen to Aarhus usually cost around 120 EUR for a return ticket per person, compared to 30-40 EUR if we book it in advance for you.

The cost of the local train/bus tickets in Denmark will, of course, be included in your travel budget.



# FINANCIAL

Accommodation, meals, and travel costs will be covered for all participants. However, the upper limit for the travel budget varies for each country, as outlined below.

# FINANCIAL

As a general rule, participants are requested to keep all tickets, invoices and, if applicable, boarding passes, in order to be eligible for refunding. We strongly recommend that you check-in online for your flights and take a screenshot of the boarding passes.

In order to receive the travel reimbursement for the whole group, the group leaders from each country must follow 2 simple steps:

**Step 1.** Group leader gathers ALL the travel documents from its national team, electronically. These include, but are not limited to: bus/train tickets, flights, invoices and any other relevant receipts.

**Step 2.** Group leader fills out the Reimbursement Form below and uploads ALL travel documentation directly in the reimbursement form.

Timeline for the reimbursement process:

- **03. October – 15. November:** group leaders submit the travel documentation via the Reimbursement Form below.
- **15 November – 15. December:** we process the travel documents.
- **15. December – 5. January:** we send an overview with the final amounts for each national group for confirmation.
- **5. January – 15. January:** we finalize the payment and transfer the funds to you.

# WHAT TO BRING?

Weather in Denmark is usually warm during summer. Therefore, bring appropriate clothes with you.

Also, take some basic pills with you in case you get sick or catch a cold. If you follow a special treatment which requires specific medication, remember to take it along with you as well.

Regarding the **intercultural evenings**, feel free to bring your flag together with traditional food, snacks or drinks with you. However, the maximum limit for alcohol is 5 Litres per country.
