Here is the story of our brother, NOOR AHMAD BOLSTAD, from Norway. This youngman desires to become a Missionary of Islam and thus be able to spread the light, which led him out of the darkness. He says:

"The story of my way from Church to Mosque is a story about a boy who had not much to do with the Church, but has a lot to do with the Mosque.

I was born in Oslo, the capital of Norway, in 1941. Till I was about 14 years of age, I did not give much thought to religion or the existence of God, but at that time I started to read a lot about it, only to find out that I did not understand anything.

One year later, when I was a pupil in the high school, I met one who gave me some pamphlets on Islam published by the Ahmadiyya Missionary, Kamal Yousuf, in Sweden. I began to correspond with him and later on also with

a Swedish Muslim by the name Mahmud Eriksson. Thanks to these, and the understanding Allah gave me in His mercy, I soon found that Islam was the Truth.

On 2nd Feb, 1957, I signed Bai'at and became Muslim. I feel that I, on the day entered the ranks of the millions of Muslims all over the world who believe in, and love, the Truth, and since then I have tried to live like a Muslim.

Just now I am serving as a solider, but I hope that it will, later on, be possible for me to come to Rabwah and study Islam, and then go out in the world as a missionary when my studies are finished. I pray to Allah that He may let it happen so to me, Amen!"
