
# The European Union will be climate neutral by 2050



### -55% by 2030

- On 14 July 2021, the European Commission adopted a set of proposals to make the EU's climate, energy, land use, transport and taxation policies fit for reducing net greenhouse gas emissions by at least 55% by 2030, compared to 1990 levels.
- Achieving these emission reductions is crucial to Europe becoming the world's first climate-neutral continent by 2050 and making the European Green Deal a reality.





### **REPowerEU**

- Affordable, secure and sustainable energy for Europe
  - Saving energy
  - Producing clean energy
  - Diversifying our energy supplies



### **REPowerEU**

#### A few examples...

- Increase renewables target for 2030 from 40 to 45%
- 320 GW of solar photovoltaic by 2025 (600 GW by 2030)
- Faster permitting for renewable energy projects

# European Green Deal: Communication tips for **EDCs**



96% of Europeans

have taken at least **one action** to tackle climate change.



93% of Europeans

believe climate change is a **serious problem**.



90% of Europeans

agree that greenhouse gas emissions should be reduced to make the **EU climate-neutral by 2050**.

People finding it easier to engage in climate action and accessing new ways and tools for existing action to be connected, amplified and supported




Public support for climate action grows, enabling policymakers mandate to act




### How to take action and join the Pact?
