

How does Erasmus+ work? The actors involved



Students, Staff from HEIs and other organisations



New mobility type and durations

Mobility activities:

- Student mobility for studies:
 - Short-term 5-30 days
 - Long-term 2-12 months
- Student mobility for traineeships:
 - Short-term 5-30 days
 - Long-term 2-12 months
- Staff mobility for teaching: 1-60 days
- Staff mobility for training: 2-60 days

Other activities:

Blended intensive programmes

Erasmus+ higher education mobility New priorities and new mobility features

- International dimension: Worldwide mobility all students and staff, going to all countries in the world
- 2. Digital education: Blended mobility (physical stays + virtual collaboration) and blended intensive programmes
- 3. Inclusion & diversity: Inclusive mobility for persons from diverse backgrounds higher grants and more flexible mobility formats
- 4. Link to research: Doctoral short-term student and staff mobility and long-term student mobility complementing Marie Sklodowska-Curie Actions
- Sustainability: Greener, more sustainable mobility is financially encouraged



Erasmus+ higher education mobility Student mobility grants

- Long-term intra-European student mobility (EUR33 + UK + CH)
 - Individual support base rates for studies: 200 600 EUR per month, set by the national agencies
 - Individual support top-up for fewer opportunities: **250 EUR** per month, criteria by the national agencies
 - Individual support top-up for traineeships: 150 EUR per month
- Long-term international student mobility outgoing to the world
 - Individual support: **700 EUR** per month
 - Travel support: according to distance band
- Short-term student mobility
 - Individual support base rates: **70 / 50 EUR** per day; top-up for fewer opportunities
- Funded travel days

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters & mobility

- EMJM: High-level integrated & transnational study programme at Master level
- Offering high-level scholarships to excellent students worldwide
- Applicants:
 - ✓ must hold a first higher education degree or equivalent
 - ✓ must not have benefited previously from an EMJM scholarship
- The best ones can benefit from a scholarship depending on the number of scholarships available
- Students apply directly to the EMJM consortium

Mobility in European University alliances



- Alliances funded since 2019, renewed funding since 2022
- 340 higher education institutions in 44 alliances in 31 countries
- Target of 50% of student mobility of those enrolled in alliance HEIs
- Mobility can be physical, virtual or blended
