• Networking and Collaboration

The LQT-BE, Day Walk certification provides a platform to connect and collaborate with other certified trails across Denmark and Europe.

Who can participate in the training course?

Representatives from municipalities, tourism organizations, national parks, nature reserves, hiking organization, local groups involved in walking, landowners etc.

Why participate in the training course?

Completing in the training course is the first mandatory step, if you wish to have a local hiking trail certified as LQT-BE DAY WALK.

During the 2-full-day training course you will

- get **full knowledge of the quality criteria** for LQT-BE Day Walk; including the waymarking rules; the eight Day Walk themes, the criteria regarding starting point, attractions, landscape, trail surface, noise etc.
- learn all about the **certification process** including how to collect data on your trail; how to improve your trail, process for application etc.
- get **practical training** on walking tours in the field. You will practice how to collect data in the field and register information regarding the trail.

After completing the training course you will

- have the title of *"trained trail scout"*
- know how to plan for and evaluate a trail to become a LQT-BE Day Walk
- be able to apply for a LQT-BE Day Walk certification for one/more of your local hiking trails (*Be aware that <u>only</u> trained trail scouts can be responsible for the application and certification process for a local trail).*

Who will be teaching at the training course?

Educated ERA experts will be in charge of the training course: Steen Kobberø-Hansen and Jana Harnochová.

When is registration deadline?
