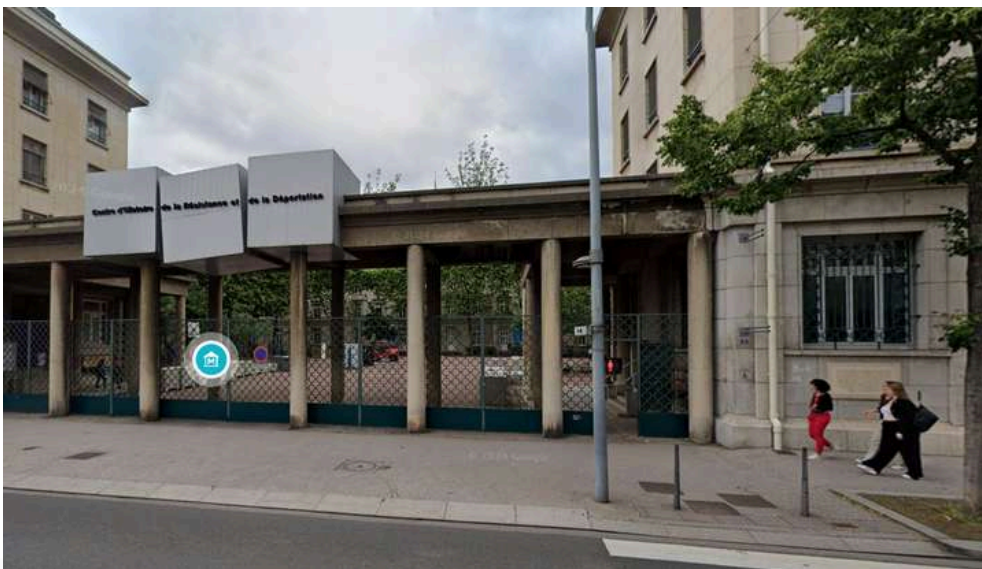

The event will be held at “Maison des sciences de l’Homme”.

The site is located near the university campus “Université Lyon 2 Berges du Rhône”, in the center of Lyon on the Banks of the Rhône.

At the entrance, it is marked "Centre d’histoire de la résistance et de la déportation". In the courtyard, the Maison des Sciences de l'Homme building will be on your right.



Access to the MSH

The MSH is served by tramway T2 (Centre Berthelot stop).

The nearest metro station is Place Jean Macé (line B).

If you are taking the train or public transport...

From Perrache Station (most convenient):

- Take tramway line T2 towards St-Priest Bel-Air to the Centre Berthelot stop;
- Or walk across the Gallieni Bridge (15 min).

From Part-Dieu Station:

- Take metro line B towards Gare d'Oullins to the Jean Macé stop, then walk up Avenue Berthelot (in the opposite direction to traffic);
- Or take tramway line T1 towards Debourg to the Quai Claude Bernard stop, then continue on foot to Avenue Berthelot and follow the direction of traffic.

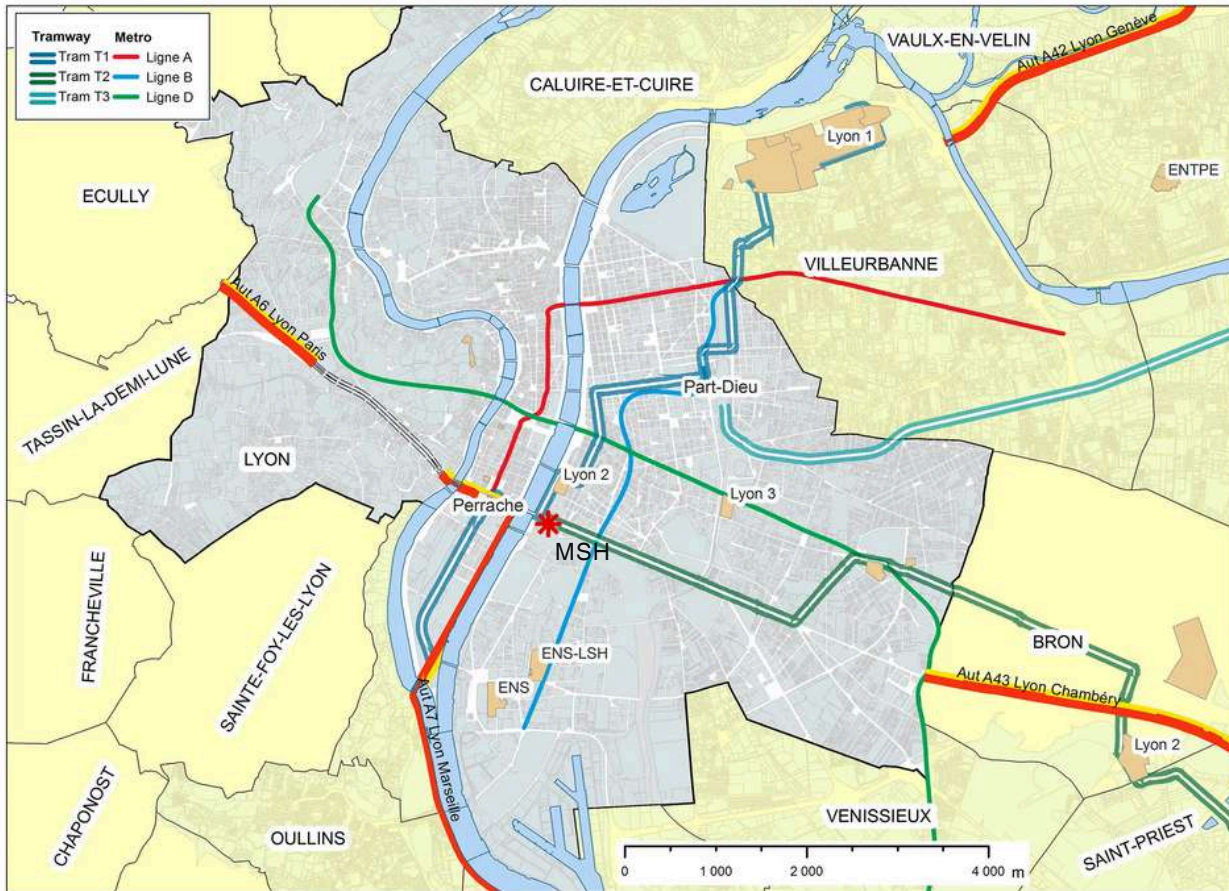
If you are flying...

Lyon Saint-Exupéry is an international airport served by most airlines.

At the airport, you can take the express tram (Rhônexpress) to downtown Lyon (30 min). The departure is from the airport train station, level -1.

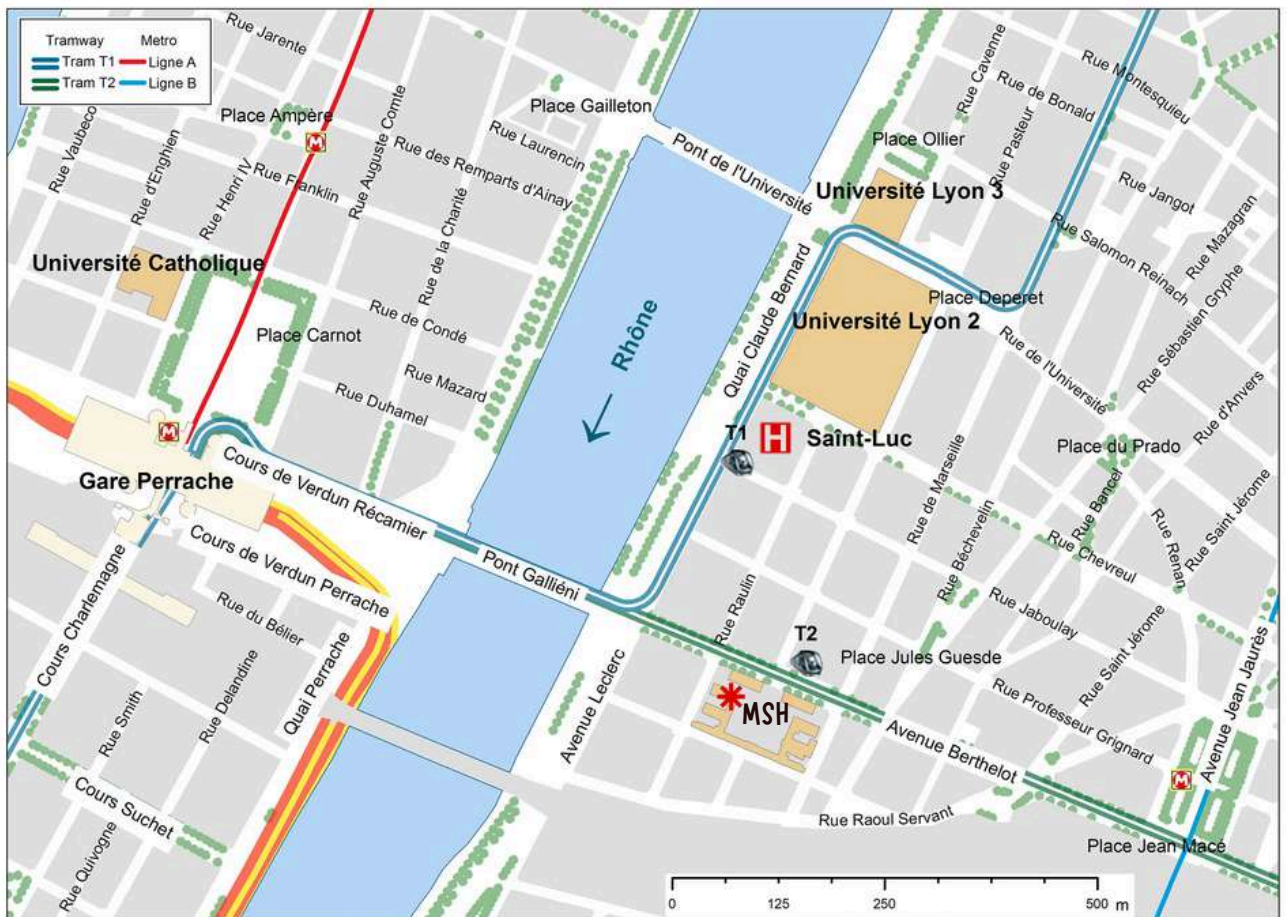

By train, Lyon (Part-Dieu station) is 2 hours from Paris (Gare de Lyon) and 2 hours from Marseille (Gare Marseille Saint Charles).

Hotels

There are a wide variety of hotels available, but since Lyon is a very touristy city, I recommend making your reservation as soon as possible. Here is a selection of hotels closest to our meeting site.

For more choices...

If you don't mind walking, staying on the peninsula (between the Rhône and the Saône, around Place Bellecour) is a great option. You will be in the beautiful tourist center of Lyon and can cross the Rhône via the Gallieni Bridge (on foot or by tram) to reach the Maison des Sciences de l'Homme.

Since our meeting location is served by both the metro and tram, you can also broaden your search geographically to find accommodations with the best value for money. Feel free to contact us if you would like advice on which neighborhoods to prioritize.

You might consider getting up earlier to have breakfast in town, at a café or a bakery, as this can also be a more economical option.

Additional information

Lyon, known as the gastronomic capital, may tempt you to visit some of the city's renowned restaurants during your stay. Be aware that for Michelin-starred restaurants, you need to make reservations several weeks in advance, especially for Paul Bocuse's restaurant.

One of the social activities will take place at 'La Brasserie Saint Georges'. You'll receive more information about the social activities a few weeks before the meeting.
