RECFISH

In RecFish, hundreds of recreational fishermen active at sea, in harbours and on beaches, share their data with scientists, and by doing this, could contradict the claim that recreational sea fishing is a threat and competitor to professional fishing.

A ground-breaking initiative that include fishers' knowledge in fisheries management by letting them participate in data collection in Norway.
