This led to a re-think of the organisation's structure and finance income. A SoS campaigned helped bridge the gap in funding that was denied and a reduction in staff and some services meant we were able to keep our doors open. Through this the charity has continued to grow its service user base with 414 new service users visiting us in the period. Our overall engagement reach was 3943 with an additional 2751 people reached through events and awareness campaigns. In total Four Pillars supported approximately | | | | |
