Interview Guide

Overview

To gain a better understanding of users and potential stakeholders for the design of modular equipment or a furniture system to support agile ways of working (the product).

I will record the interviews to accurately record stakeholder's ideas. Then, I will transcribe the recordings verbatim. Next, I will send a copy of the transcript to the interviewee and ask them to review the contents. At this stage, I will invite stakeholders to add or edit their comments. I will load a copy of the transcripts onto my online design journal. Stakeholder's comments and insights will be used as one of multiple research inputs to the product design.

In the research report, I will use pseudonyms to maintain confidentiality for the stakeholders.
